

Special events held at YMCA of the Rockies – Estes Park Center are subject to the rules and regulations of the YMCA and the following terms and conditions:

A. ALCOHOL/DRUG POLICY: The YMCA of The Rockies does not have a liquor serving license and our YMCA employees can not touch alcoholic beverages at the events. If you decide to have alcoholic beverages served at your banquet, the guidelines are as followed:

1. The YMCA of the Rockies is proud to partner with Peak Beverage as our exclusive beverage vendor. Please go to <https://www.peakbev.com/beverage-catering> to submit a proposal request for your event and learn more about their all-inclusive Beverage Catering packages. **If serving alcohol at your event, you must hire a bartender through Peak Beverage.**
2. Only bottled/can beer, seltzers, ciders, wine and champagne are allowed. Additional rules apply. When utilizing Peak Beverage full service packages for your event, exceptions apply for specialty cocktails or full-service bar packages. Inquire with your Peak Representative for more details.
3. Peak Beverage will provide all bartending equipment with full service bar packages. This includes bar glassware (no water glasses) including champagne flutes for a complimentary champagne toast, ice, mixers & non-alcoholic beverages, bar tables & linens as well as TIPS certified bartenders.
4. The YMCA of the Rockies will not provide cold storage for alcohol.
5. All limits of the law must be respected. Peak Beverage and YMCA staff reserve the right to dismiss any intoxicated guests in the party or terminate the event at any time.
6. No alcoholic beverages may be taken outside of the room. At the Upper Cookout Pavilion, all alcohol must remain under the physical roof of the pavilion. Guests cannot walk outside the pavilion with an open container.
7. YMCA of the Rockies is committed to a safe, healthy and productive environment and does not allow any marijuana (medical or recreational) at any time.
8. Alcohol is not permitted at any of the chapels, whether indoor or outdoor.

There is ZERO TOLERANCE concerning the alcohol/drug policy. If this policy is violated by any guest in the party, the event will be over.
