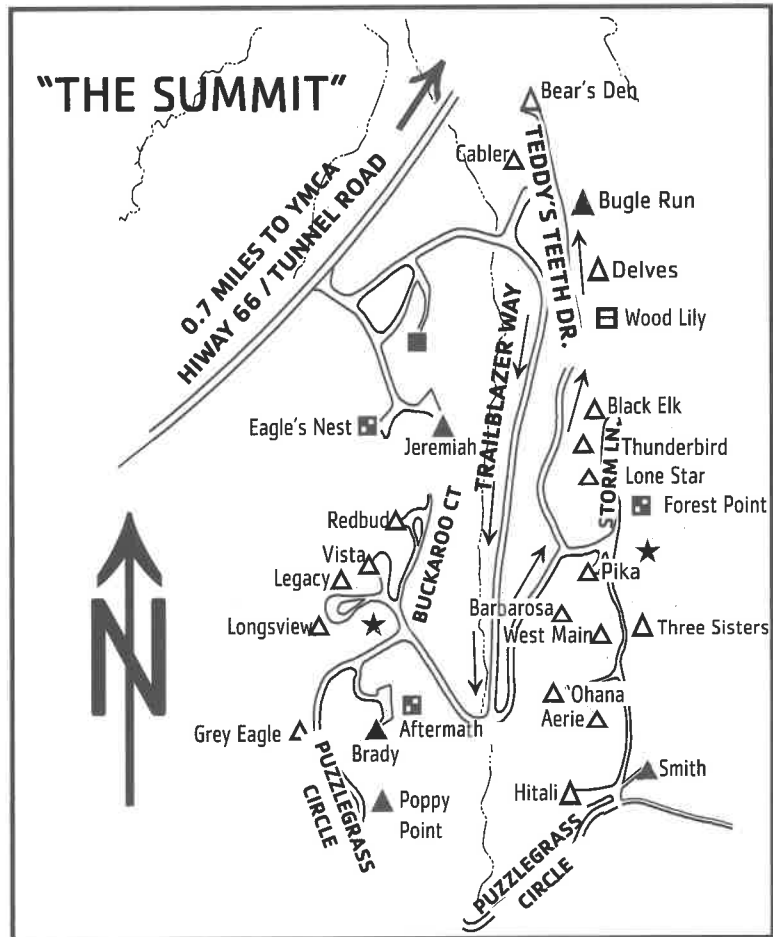

## Important Things for You to Know During Your Stay at Estes Park Center YMCA of the Rockies

Additional information can be found in the Activity Guide and the Guest Services Directory in your cabin or lodge room.

**Check-Out is 10:00 am.** This time is strictly enforced out of consideration for the guests checking in after you and our hardworking housekeeping staff; however, after you check out of your lodging, you are welcome to enjoy our grounds, recreational activities and facilities for the rest of the day. Anyone checking out after 10:00 am will be subject to a half-day charge.

**Fire Safety:** When allowed, campfires are permitted in designated campfire sites only; contact the Program Department at ext. 1104 for availability and pricing. Charcoal grills are prohibited on YMCA grounds. Propane gas grills are permitted and a very limited number are available for rent through the Conference Office; dial ext. 1021 for availability and pricing.

**Pets:** Pets are allowed in most two, three and four bedroom cabins; they are not allowed in reunion cabins, lodge rooms, meeting rooms, the Administration Building or other public buildings. Pets must be on a leash at all times while outside on YMCA grounds. There is a charge of \$25 per pet per night.

**Telephones:** Each cabin and lodge room is equipped with a telephone enabled with voice mail service. Voice mail messages can be retrieved by dialing 1251 and following the automated prompts; your password is the same as your cabin or room extension. For local or long distance calls, dial 9 and then the phone number. Local calls are free for the first 30 minutes; calls over 30 minutes are charged 5 cents per minute plus tax. Long distance calls within the United States are charged 25 cents per minute plus tax.

**Wildlife Safety:** Do not attempt to feed, approach or otherwise attract or harass wild animals. If you are in a cabin, please use the bear-proof trash cans and put garbage out before noon for collection in the afternoon. Bears, Raccoons, and other wildlife have excellent sense of smell and will find food. **DO NOT LEAVE** food outside in coolers, on window sills, or in cars. Lock your vehicle to prevent bears from opening its doors.
